Renovation of Retail Space

The project consisted of 69,000 square feet. The building also has a 30,000 square foot former grocery store currently leased out for storage. That space will eventually be developed into additional church space as the need arises.

Project included: A main sanctuary which seats 1790, plus 103 choir, and 125 on the platform. The small auditorium seats 294, plus 80 on the platform. It also included completely new plumbing, electrical, and HVAC equipment, as well as a fully equipped commercial kitchen serving the fellowship hall. The fellowship hall serves up to 400 or more, depending on seating arrangements. Education and administration space with a conference room was also included. The facility featured a bookstore and a foyer that accommodates over 400 people and is used for receptions.

The interior garage features four overhead doors, plus a loading dock and storage area. The former K-Mart store has ample parking, and is on a highly visible location across from a former mall. Storage is abundant, and several rooms are listed as Miscellaneous.

Construction began in May 2005 and was completed in July 2006.

Project cost was \$4,832,544.82
